NOTICE

OF

RACE

The Royal Yacht Club of Victoria Inc. invites entries from the Yachts on the Register of the Royal Yacht Club of Victoria or kindred clubs.

The Series will be sailed on Port Phillip under the authority of the Royal Yacht Club of Victoria Inc.

The Races are to be conducted on alternate Sundays during the Summer season starting at 11:00. (Refer to the Club Calendar for race dates)

Season 2017-2018:- start date 08 October 2017 – end date 25 March 2018
Scheduled number of races 11

RULES

All races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions and safety regulations of the AS, and the Port of Melbourne regulations - all as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

ELIGIBILITY

Entries shall be accepted from yachts on the Register of the Royal Yacht Club of Victoria. Entries shall hold a current Safety Equipment Declaration of Compliance for Category 6. Tripe and Onions division entries shall be under 10m LOA. (This is a small boat series primarily for Division 3 type boats)
Larger entries shall be entered in the Steak and Mushrooms division.
A point score will be kept for each division.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The safety of the yacht and its crew, including insurance, is the sole responsibility of the owner/competitor racing the yacht. All those taking part in the Race do so at their own risk and responsibility. The organising yacht club is not responsible for the seaworthiness of the yacht whose entry is accepted or for the sufficiency or the adequacy of its equipment.

Attention is drawn to WS Racing Rule 4.

The responsibility for a boats decision to participate in a race or continue racing is hers alone.

A series entry fee of \$18 per race is applicable to this event. Casual entries will be charged at the standard club casual rate (\$30).

ENTRIES

Entries should be lodged with the Royal Yacht Club of Victoria via the RYCV Online Entry System.

EVENT CLASSIFICATION

The Regatta is classified as a Category C event in accordance with Racing Rules of Sailing.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available from the foyer of the Royal Yacht Club of Victoria each Race day.

SCORING

A series will be scored in accordance with the RRS with eight races to count. A minimum of three races shall constitute a series.
