The Start line will be a line between the Start mark and an orange flag displayed on the Start Boat.

The Course is as follows;

Start - R4 to port – Gellibrand to Starboard – Pipeline 3 to Starboard – Altona Bay to port – Point Cook to port – Altona Bay to port – Point Cook to Port – P2 to port – R4 to port to Finish

The Finish line will be an imaginary line between the Flag Staff on the Northern end of the RYCV Marina and No 20 PoMC channel Pile

The Time limit is sunset, boats finishing after this time will be scored DNF.
