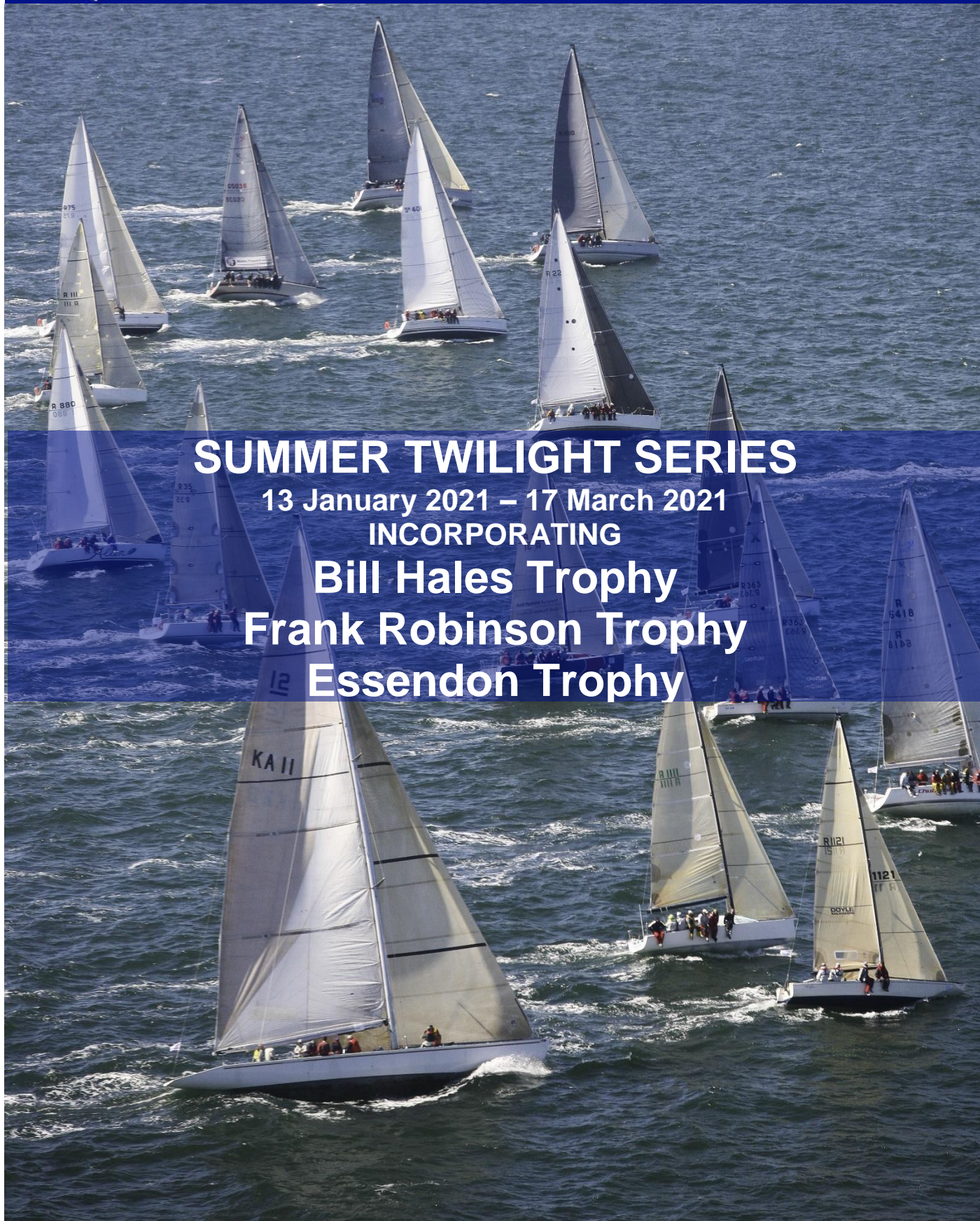

NOTICE OF RACE



Royal Yacht Club of Victoria Inc. and Hobsons Bay Yacht Club Inc. as Organising Authority invite entries from the Yachts on the Registers of the Royal Yacht Club of Victoria and Hobsons Bay Yacht Club Inc.

The Regatta will be sailed on Port Phillip.

The Regatta is a twenty-one race event run on Wednesdays between 13 January 2021 and 17 March 2021.

1. RULES

All races will be governed by the WS Racing Rules, the prescriptions and Special Regulations of Australian Sailing, and the VPC regulations - all as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY

Entries shall be accepted from yachts on the Register of the Royal Yacht Club of Victoria or the Hobson's Bay Yacht Club holding a current Safety Equipment Declaration of Compliance.

3. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The safety of the yacht and its crew, including insurance, is the sole responsibility of the owner/competitor racing the yacht. All those taking part in the Regatta do so at their own risk and responsibility. The organising clubs are not responsible for the seaworthiness of the yacht whose entry is accepted or for the sufficiency or the adequacy of its equipment.

Attention is drawn to WS Rule 4. A boat is solely responsible for deciding whether or not to start or to continue racing.

4. ENTRIES

Entries should be lodged with the Royal Yacht Club of Victoria or Hobsons Bay Yacht Club Office. A series fee of \$24.00 per race is applicable. Casual entries may be accepted at the rate of \$30.00 a race. Late entry fees may be applied.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions are available online or from the offices of the Royal Yacht Club of Victoria or Hobson's Bay Yacht Club. Note: The instructions are amended from last year.

6. DIVISIONS

Boats will be divided into divisions based on size and Handicap. Each division shall have its own Course and Scoring. The decision of the RYCV/HBYC Race and Handicap committee in the allocation of Handicaps and Division shall be final.

7. SCORING SYSTEM

The Series shall be scored under Appendix A Low Points as modified in part A9.

Ten races are scheduled. After seven races have been completed a boat's worst score shall be discarded, after eight races have been completed a boat's two worst scores shall be discarded, after ten races have been completed a boat's three worst scores shall be discarded, after twenty-one races are completed a boat's four worst scores shall be discarded.
