





Notice of Race

Off The Beach Summer Series 7 November 2021 to 10 April 2022

The Royal Yacht Club of Victoria Inc (RYCV) invites entries from Off-The-Beach (OTB) sailing boats to compete in the above events on the waters of Hobsons Bay, Victoria under the following conditions.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing including the prescriptions of Australian Sailing (RRS)
- 1.2 The Australian Sailing (AS) Special Regulations Part 2 will apply.
- 1.3 The International Cadet Class rules will apply to the Cadet Class.
- 1.4 Reasonable actions by event officials to implement COVID-19 guidance, protocols, or legislation, even if they later prove to have been unnecessary, are not improper actions or omissions.
- 1.5 [DP] Denotes a rule for which the penalty will be applied by Race Committee without a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1 and A5.
- 1.6 [NP] Denotes a rule for which that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The sailing instructions will be available from the office of the RYCV and the OTB page of the club's website www.rycv.com.au from 12 November 2021

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The official notice board is located in the OTB rooms
- 3.2 [DP] While racing except in an emergency a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice and data transmissions or data communication that is not available to all boats.
- 3.3 The race committee will operate on VHF Ch 15, unless otherwise advised during the briefing.
- 3.4 A race briefing will take place at about 1245 at the OTB rooms

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 Entries will be accepted from off the beach boats on the RYCV club register or the register of an AS affiliated yacht club
- 4.2 Junior sailors must have a consent form completed by a parent or guardian and submitted to sailmanager@rycv.asn.au before the beginning of the season.



- 4.3 Eligible boats shall enter the series by registering online at https://rycv.com.au/sailing/off-the-beach/entry/
- 4.4 Series entry will close at 1700 on Wednesday 25 November 2021. Casual race entries shall close on the Thursday before each race. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the race committee.

5 FEES

- 5.1 Boats skippered by a RYCV junior member shall enter the season free of charge.
- 5.2 Boats skippered by a RYCV member shall pay \$100 for the season or \$10 per casual race day
- 5.3 Boats skippered by a non RYCV member shall pay a series entry of \$50 for a junior or \$125 for a senior or \$15 for casual race day.
- 5.4 A Late entry fee of \$50 for series entry or \$5 for a casual entry shall apply
- 5.5 Members of the Port Melbourne Yacht Club may enter RYCV casually free of charge. PMYC extends the same courtesy to RYCV sailors for their Saturday racing.

7 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

7.1 [DP] At the direction from the RO, a boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules, AS equipment regulations, and the sailing instructions.

8 VENUE

8.1 Racing will take place on the waters of Hobsons Bay

9 COURSES

9.1 Courses will be as described in the Sailing Instructions

10 SCORING

- 10.1 The scoring system is as detailed in Appendix A of RRS.
- 10.2 For the Aggregate series (Cadet and Senior OTB),
- 10.2.1 Up to 10 races may be included.
- 10.2.2 The minimum number of races to be sailed to constitute a series is three.
- 10.2.3 As allowed in part A2.1, after four races have been completed a boat's worst score shall be discarded, after eight races have been completed a boat's two worst scores shall be discarded.
- 10.3 For the Club Championship series (Cadet and Senior OTB),
- 10.3.1 Up to six races may be included.
- 10.4 The minimum number of races to be sailed to constitute a series is one.
- 10.5 As allowed in part A2.1, after five races have been completed a boat's worst score shall be discarded.
- 10.6 For the Arch Cawthorne Series (Cadet),
- 10.6.1 Boats are to be skippered by sailors who are normally crew.
- 10.6.2 Up to three races may be included.
- 10.6.3 Minimum number of races to be sailed to constitute a series is one.
- 10.6.4 There will be no discards.



10.6.5 Aggregate Races will only be sailed on days that are scheduled for Aggregate Races. Sailors will be advised in the briefing when the second race of the day will count towards this series.

11 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

- 11.1 [DP] Support person vessels shall familiarise themselves with RRS 37 and always monitor the race committee channel between launching and retrieval, or the last boat finishes the last race of the day whichever is earlier
- 11.2 Support person vessels shall remain a minimum 50m from any boat racing

12 RISK STATEMENT

12.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes.

13 INSURANCE

13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per incident or the equivalent.

14 PRIZES

- 14.1 Only RYCV members are eligible for perpetual trophies
- 14.2 Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Race Committee.
- 14.3 Cadets and Junior OTB Classes
