#### Location

Depending on availability, the length of your stay and the requirements of your vessel, we may either allocate you a pen in the marina or direct you to raft up alongside a section of wharf. Please ensure you have adequate mooring lines and fenders on-board to secure your vessel. Please note some marina pens may not have suitable lines available for your vessel.

- 1. No Berthing in the travel lift pen unless directed by the Waterfront Staff
- 2. No Berthing under the western hardstand crane
- 3. No Berthing alongside the western side of the east hardstand pontoon
- 4. No Berthing under the eastern hardstand crane


