Note The start/ finish line will be an imaginary line between the start box and an inflatable buoy (mark X-

ray) approximately. .5nm from the start box on a bearing of 232 degrees.

When starting there is a designated obstruction line between channel marks

19 and 21, yachts may NOT pass to the west of this line.

At the finish competitors will need to take their own time in the format

Hour: Min: Sec: and advise race control of their finishing time on VHF 69 within

10 minutes of finishing. PLEASE DO NOT USE ELAPSED TIME

THE start sequence will be conducted by signals from the start box and on RADIO channel VHF 69.

To help our starters it is necessary to advise that you are a starter and as such you are requested to sign in between 10.15 cm / 10.45 cm using shapped VIIIE 10.

in between 10.15am / 10.45am using channel VHF69.

**Note 2:** Scoring is as per the Notice of Race. The boats listed in the second column are larger than the size limit and are ineligible for the Tripe and Onions Trophy and will be scored for the Steak and Mushrooms Trophy. Unless the boat is entered through Topyacht there will be no score generated.

**Note 3** Courses shall be selected from those listed in the combined Hobsons Bay Yacht Club and RYCV Club course book which can be found on the RVYC web site.

**Course 1** Start in a South easterly direction .

V to port-R4 to port - Xray to port - V to port-R4 to port- Xray to port - V to port-

R4 to port-Finish in a South-easterly direction

Course 2 Start in a North-Easterly direction .

R4 to starboard - V to starboard-Xray to starboard - R4 to starboard- V to starboard-

Xray to starboard - R4 to starboard-V to starboard-finish in a North-westerly

direction

**Course 3** Start in a South-easterly direction passing marks.

V to starboard - Gellibrand Shoal to starboard - P3 to starboard- Gellibrand Shoal to

port - V to port- finish in a North-westerly direction

**Course 12** Start in a South easterly direction all marks to port.

V to port-RMYS A to port-RMYS D to port-R4 to port-finish in a South-easterly

direction

**Course 13** Start in a North-easterly direction all marks to Starboard.

R4 to starboard-RMYS D to starboard-RMYS A to starboard-V to starboard-finish

in a North-westerly direction

Course 42 Start in a North-easterly direction. Start Mark XRAY

Start in a north-easterly direction R4 to starboard- RMYS C to port

RMYS D to port- R4 to port- V mark to starboard

Finish in a north-westerly direction. Finish mark XRAY.

Course 43 Start / Finish – At Xray mark

Start in a southerly direction **V** to port

R4 to starboard - RMYS D to starboard

RMYS C to starboard - R4 to port

Finish in a south westerly direction

**Course 44** Start in a northeasterly direction

R4 to starboard, RMYS G to starboard, R3 to starboard,

Passing Ch pile 71 to Port, V mark to starboard, R 4 to Port

Finish in a south-westerly direction.
