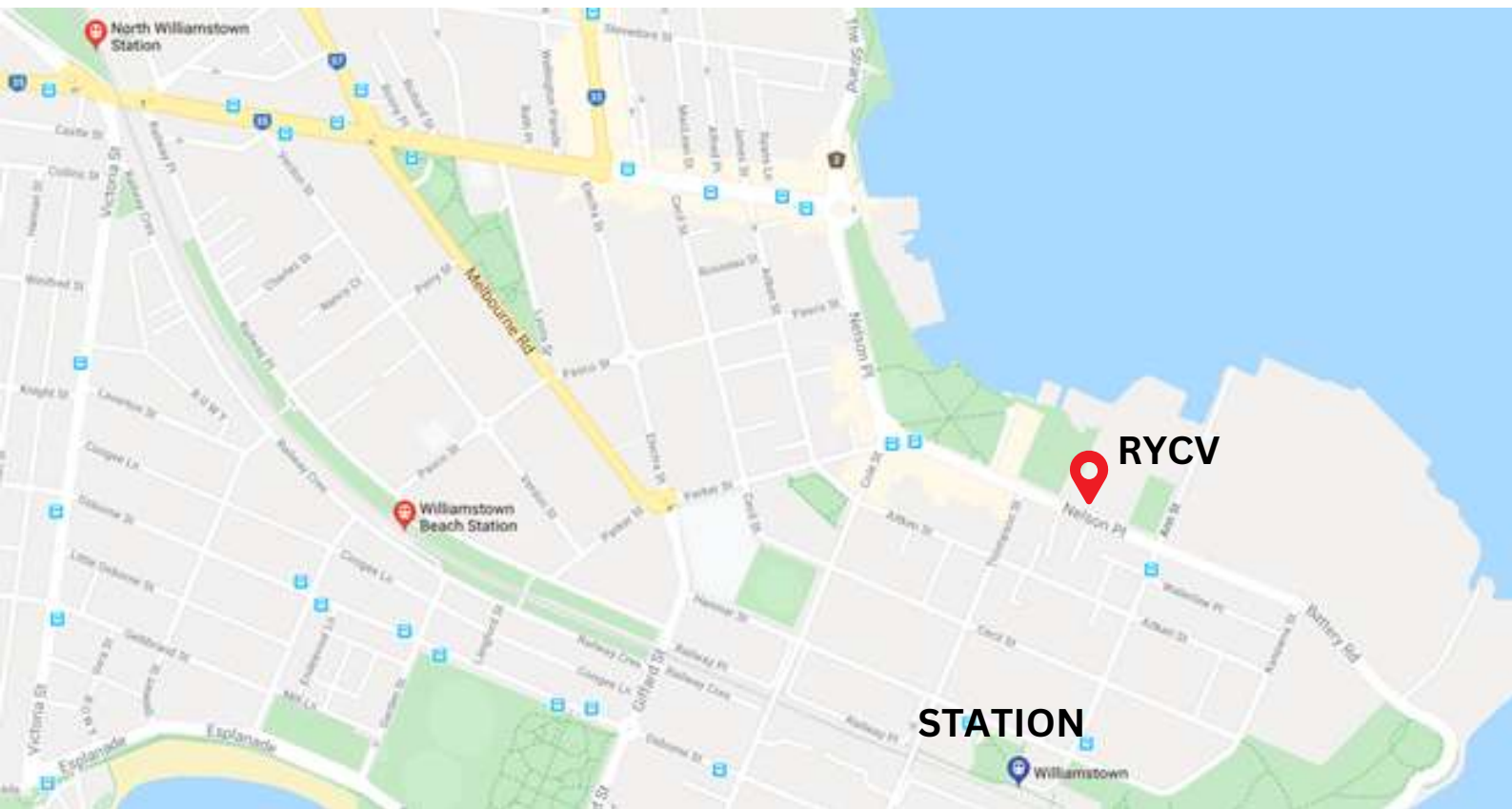

ON ARRIVAL FOR EVENT & ROAD TRAILER PARKING

No cars are to be parked in in the trailer area.

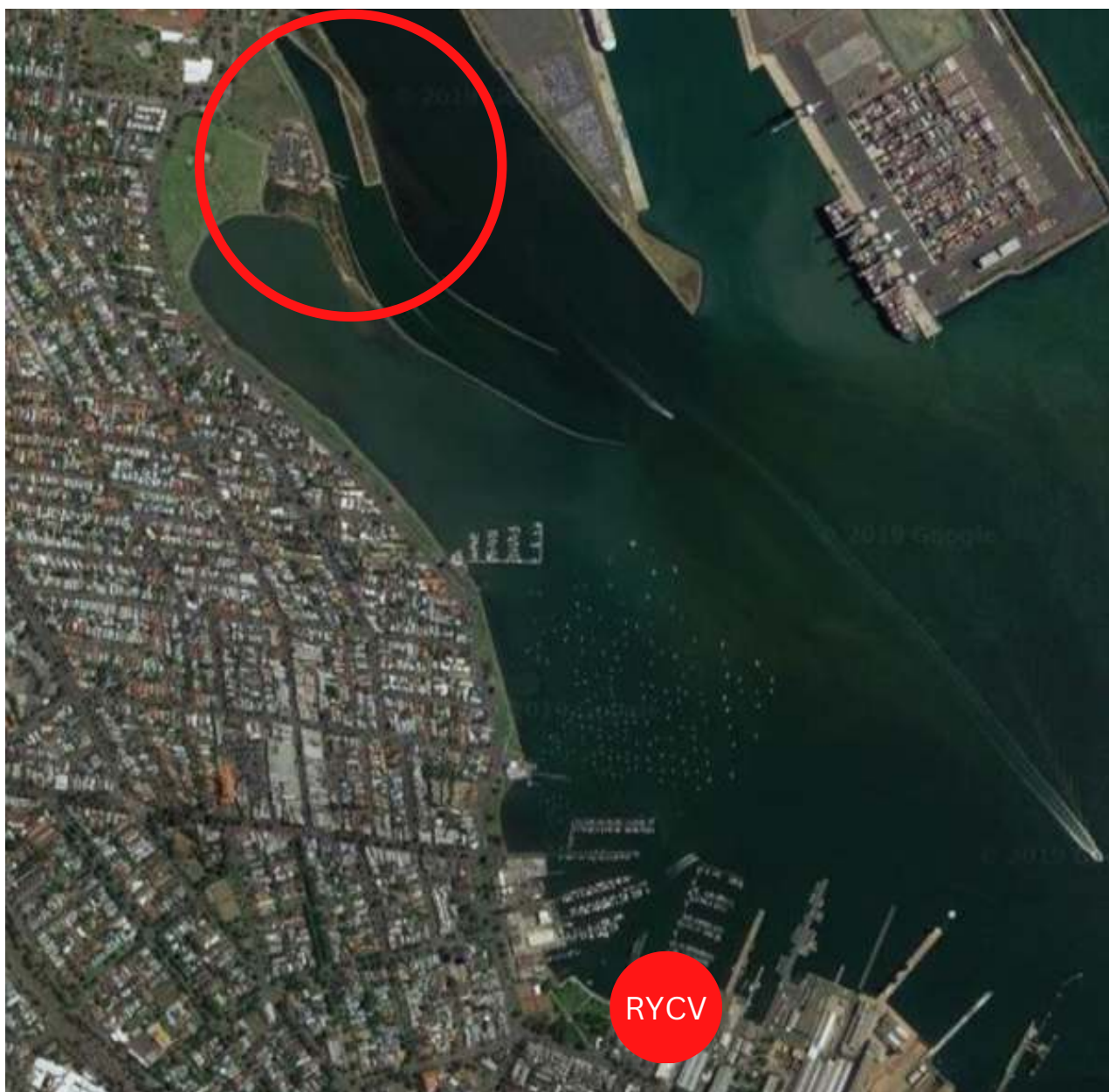
Car parking in the RYCV carpark is reserved for Full RYCV Members only. There is ample all day on-street car parking available within a short walk of the Club.

LAUNCHING AND RETRIEVING SUPPORT BOATS

Any support boats can be launched at Warmies Boat Ramp, which is free to use, or by club crane if arrangements have been prior to arrival, and with rated lifting equipment/slings etc.



REGISTRATION & MEASUREMENT

Registration and measurement will take place on the deck located on the northern side of the clubhouse.

To ensure a relaxed registration process at the event, we've prepared the following checklist so that you can arrive confident that you have everything covered:

- You must have a current insurance certificate for your boat, including cover not less than AUD \$10,000,000 for any accident
- Names and AS number for helm and crew
- Age bracket for helms
- Measurement certificate for boat

For daily safety checks you will need:

- Suitable life jackets properly fitted and adjusted
- At least 1 bailer compliant with class rules tied in the boat
- The centreboard must have a lanyard tied in or clipped into boat
- Paddle secured to boat
- Tow rope
- Bulk head covers installed correctly.

UV rays can be seen or felt and can damage your skin on cool or cloudy days.

When UV is 3+

- Slip on covering clothing
- Slop on SPF30 or higher, broad spectrum sunscreen
- Slap on a broad brimmed hat
- Seek shade
- Slide on sunglasses

Download the SunSmart app to find sun protection time for your location in Australia. Available from the App Store, Google Play or via the QR code below.

Features

- UV and sun protection alerts each day.
- A sunscreen calculator, providing you with the minimum recommended sunscreen application, based on your choice of outfit. Plus, a two-hour reminder so you don't forget to top up.
- Four-day forecast of sun protection times and weather information.
- Live UV levels for major cities, and forecast UV for all other locations.

1. Take your time to explore over 20 kilometres of coastal pathways and enjoy the tranquil setting with cityscape views, beaches and foreshores, and an array of nature to admire.



2. Take a scenic seaplane flight. *



3. Explore Newport lakes, located off Mason Street, Newport. 33 ha of Tranquil bird-rich parklands with walking tracks, lakes, kid's play equipment and BBQ spots.



4. Wander around historic Williamstown waterfront. Discovering some of Melbourne's maritime history from stately homes to quaint seaman's cottages.



5. Visit the Williamstown Botanic Gardens, established in the 1850s.



6. Snorkel at the Jawbone Marine Sanctuary, Williamstown.



7. Work up an appetite and check out the many local eateries across Hobsons Bay.



8. Stand up paddle with Sun Seekers in Altona.



9. Swim at Altona or Williamstown beaches.



9. Rock climb at one of the three indoor climbing centres, Cliff Hanger, Clip and Climb or Climb West.



10. Go on board the HMAS Castlemaine Maritime Museum at Gem Pier, Williamstown. Open weekends and public holidays, with extended days during the Christmas New Year period.*



11. Grab a movie ticket at one of the local cinemas Reading, Altona North or Sun Theatre, Yarraville.



12. Visit the Newport Railway Museum or Altona Miniature Railway.*



13. Walk the 100 steps to federation and take in the views over the Bay and across to the You Yangs. Truganina Coastal Park, Altona Meadows.



14. Take the skateboards and BMX bikes to one of two skate parks.



15. Explore further afield and hop on the West Gate punt to Port Melbourne. Travelling under the famous West Gate Bridge.*

16. Play a game of badminton at the Altona Badminton Centre, 271 Mason Street, Altona North.

17. Check out Seaworks Maritime Museum and Discovery Centre on Nelson Place, Williamstown. Here you can immerse yourself amongst impressive display of artefacts and models that showcase maritime history.*

18. Challenge yourself at Scienceworks in Spotswood, and see the Pumping Station, current exhibition, Melbourne Planetarium, and Lightning Room.

19. Enjoy the feel of village shopping in six diverse locations without the hustle and bustle of the city.

20. Wander through the Truganina Explosives Reserve, Altona on the first Sunday of the month.

21. Swim in the indoor pool at Bay Fit, 257 Mason Street, Altona North.
