Royal Yacht Club of Victoria Yacht as the Organising Authority invites entries for the Bluebird Class 2020 State Championships

1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing
- 1.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia (YA) shall apply
- 1.3 The Bluebird Association Class Rules shall apply.

2. Advertising

- 2.1 Boats shall if required by the Organizing Authority; display in locations specified any logos, pennants or promotional material as may be supplied.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The regatta is open to Bluebird class boats, on the register of a yacht club affiliated with YA.
- 3.2 Entry is open to all financial members of the Bluebird Class Association of Victoria.
- 3.3. Eligible boats may enter online at the RYCV website.
- 3.4 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee

4. Fees

- 4.1 The entry fee for the series is \$ 85.00 per boat.
A daily entry fee of \$30 will also be available.

5. Schedule

- 5.1 Racing to be conducted on Dates are:
Saturday 1st February, Saturday 15th February, Saturday 22nd February and
Sunday 15th March 2020.
- 5.2 No more than two races will be conducted on each day; the warning signal for the
first race each day is scheduled for 10.55 hours.
- 5.3 Six short races and one long race are scheduled.

6. Sailing Instructions

- 6.1 The Racing Program & Entrants listing and Sailing Instructions will be available no
later than Wednesday 29th January 2020.

7. Venue

- 7.1 Racing will be conducted on the waters of Hobson's Bay and Northern Port Phillip
adjacent to the Royal Yacht Club of Victoria Yacht or as per RYCV COURSES for
long course race.

8. The Courses

- 8.1 Short course races will be conducted on windward-return courses as described in
the Sailing Instructions or as per the RYCV Club Courses listing for the long race.

9. Scoring

- 9.1 The low point scoring system - Appendix A2.2 of the Racing Rules shall apply.
Seven races are scheduled, of which 3 shall be completed to constitute a series. If five or
less races are completed, all scores will count. If six races are completed, the best five will
be counted. If seven races are completed, the best six will be counted.

10. Prizes

- 10.1 Prizes shall be determined and awarded at the discretion of the Bluebird Yacht
Association Committee, and presented at a presentation function.
