2. The Race Committee published NTC #23 on 12 April, the day before Race 4, the

last race in the Series, amending the Series handicap to PHS.

3. R488 lodged a request for redress on the basis that the applicable handicap should not have been changed at that late stage.

Conclusions: 1. The 'error' in the NOR not being discovered and corrected prior to the start of

the Summer Series was an 'omission' of the Organising Authority.

2. Amending the NOR at this later stage was an 'improper action' of the

Organising Authority.
