



## Supplementary Sailing Instructions For

### E) Passage Race towards Queenscliff

#### E1 RACE RADIO

The Race Committee will make Race Management announcements on VHF Channel 82 and continue to monitor this channel during the race.

#### E2 CLASS FLAG

<b>Start 1</b>	Naval Numeral 1
<b>Start 2</b>	Naval Numeral 2
<b>Start 3</b>	Naval Numeral 3

#### E4 THE START

The race will commence with flag signals as RRS26.

The starting line will be in front of the RYCV Marina.

The starting line shall be an imaginary line between the flag mast onshore bearing an orange flag and Mark 'O' to the North of the Marina.

Boats will be allocated one of the 3 starting times based on their performance handicap. Boats shall not start before their allocated start time.

The warning signal for the first start will not be made before 0825hrs.

The times for each start will be published online and on the official noticeboard no less than 24 hours prior to the start.

Competitors are reminded that the initial part of the race will be conducted in the Williamstown Channel. The race committee requests that competitors exit the channel as soon as possible once past Breakwater Pier.

No Start will be made within 30 minutes of commercial traffic passing Breakwater Pier.

If a ship movement in the Williamstown Channel necessitates the postponement of any start group or groups, this will be signaled in accordance with RRS27.3 and by radio calls.

#### E5 THE FINISH

The Finishing Line shall be the imaginary line between the West Channel Pile Light and West Channel No. 13 Mark.

Yachts should record their finishing time and provide it by SMS to 0416149167 within 1 hour of finishing. A GPS synchronized time source should be used where possible.

## E6 RETURN or OVERNIGHT AT QCYC

Within one hour of finishing or retiring	SMS the Race Mobile - 0416149167
Advise your <b>intention to either stay overnight at the destination or return</b> to a boat's home port or safe Harbor.	<u>Information Required</u> - Boat Name / Sail Number - Staying overnight or Returning to "destination" - ETA
Upon arrival at home port or safe Harbor.  <b>Confirm your safe arrival.</b>	SMS the Race Mobile – 0416149167  <u>Information Required</u> - Boat Name / Sail Number - Confirmation of arrival

This shall include boats that do not finish a race or have retired.

If considering returning to the home port on the same day, boats must be adequately equipped to comply with night sailing. Safety Category 5N highly recommended.

Boats intending to stay at QCYC overnight must book a berth using the link below:

Boats staying overnight are to self-cater and are responsible for any QCYC berthing fees.

## E7 TIME LIMITS

**[SP]** The time limit shall be Sunset. Any boat not finishing by this time will be scored DNF.

## E8 SCORING

Each starting group will use a Performance Handicap to calculate a corrected time for each boat within that group. The lowest corrected time across all start groups wins.

## E8 COURSE

Through Starting Line in an Easterly direction, pass through the line defined between Workshop Jetty and Channel Marker 20, pass Gellibrand Pile to Starboard, pass M1 (Yellow Special Purpose Mark Approx 38 03.5' S 144 52.2' E) to Starboard, to Finishing Line at West Channel Pile Light.
