### F Saturday Laid Course Races – Class Monkeys Short Course Racing

#### F1 RACE RADIO

The Race Committee will make Race Management announcements on VHF Channel 69.

Bluebird Pursuit Race

#### F4 SCHEDULE OF RACES

The schedule of races is detailed in the NOR.

This Supplementary Sailing Instruction applies to the races designated “**Class Monkey 2 x Short**” in the NOR. The races designated **Class Monkey Long Race** in NOR will be hosted by RMYS and for those races the relevant RMYS sailing instructions will apply.

#### F5 COURSES AND MARKS

Selected from the **RYCV Windward/Leeward Courses** from the combined course-book **Sailing Instruction Attachment 1 - Courses and Marks** and signaled by the display of International numeral flags no later than the warning signal.

[NP] The target time for the leading boat is 45 minutes.

#### F6 THE START

The Race shall be started according to signals as in RRS 26.

The race area will be Bravo course.

A crowding buoy may be laid in the vicinity of the committee vessel.

After the preparatory signal, but before correctly starting:

Any boat passing from the pre-start side of the starting line to the course side of the starting line between the crowding buoy and the committee vessel or any boat touching the crowding buoy shall return to the pre-start side of the starting line by passing on the course side of and around the committee vessel.

A boat starting more than 10 minutes after their starting signal shall be scored DNS

##### F6.1 Pursuit Start

The first short race of the day will be a pursuit race.

The race committee/Club Handicapper will publish a start sheet listing group start times and allocating start times for each boat.

The preparatory signal for each boat is deemed to be 4 minutes before the allocated start time.

Boats shall not start before their designated start time. Individual Recalls will be made with the display of flag X until each boat has returned to the pre-start side of the line or 2 minutes, whichever is the sooner. This alters RRS 29.1

Boats with a start time of zero minutes (0) will start with the removal of the Class Flag.

Approximately 1 minute prior to the next group start time a black ball will be displayed.

At the next group start time a sound signal will be made, and the black ball will be removed. This will be the start signal for any boat allocated to that group/start time.

This will continue until all boats have started. Radio calls may be made in conjunction with the sound and visual signals.

#### **F6.2 Fleet Start**

The second race of the day will be a fleet start race. All boats will start on the removal of the Class flag.

#### **F6 THE FINISH**

The finish line shall be an imaginary line between the flag mast bearing a blue flag on the committee vessel and the finish mark.

#### **F7 TIME LIMITS**

The time limit for each race will be two hours.

If one boat finishes within the time limit, the time limit will be extended by 20 minutes. Boats failing to finish within the extended time limit shall be scored DNF without hearing. This alters RRS 35 and A5.
