



## Supplementary Sailing Instructions For

### F Saturday Laid Course Races

#### F1 RACE RADIO

The Race Committee will make Race Management announcements on VHF Channel 69.

#### F2 CLASS FLAG

International Code Flag "R"

#### F4 COURSES AND MARKS

Selected from the **RYCV Windward/Leeward Courses** from the combined course-book **Sailing Instruction Attachment 1 - Courses and Marks** and signaled by the display of International numeral flags no later than the warning signal.

#### F5 THE START

The Race shall be started according to signals as in RRS 26.

The starting line shall be on Alpha course south of Gellibrand Shoal Mark or in the vicinity of the RMYS C mark.

The start location will be broadcast on the race channel at least 30 minutes prior to the first warning and may also be notified to competitors by SMS in advance of the race day.

A crowding buoy may be laid in the vicinity of the committee vessel.

After the preparatory signal, but before correctly starting:

Any boat passing from the pre-start side of the starting line to the course side of the starting line between the crowding buoy and the committee vessel or any boat touching the crowding buoy shall return to the pre-start side of the starting line by passing on the course side of and around the committee vessel.

A boat starting more than 10 minutes after their starting signal shall be scored DNS

#### F6 THE FINISH

The finish line shall be an imaginary line between the flag mast bearing a blue flag on the committee vessel and the finish mark.

#### F7 TIME LIMITS

The time limit for each race will be two hours.

Boats failing to finish within 60 minutes after the first boat in that division finishes or within the time limit, whichever is the latter, will be scored "Did Not Finish" (DNF). This changes RRS 35 and A4
